## 1. General statement

DMN is a professional and environmentally conscious company operating in the vehicle logistics, and fleet services sector. We acknowledge that our operations may have impacts on the environment.

## 2. Aims and objectives

At DMN we fully commit to:

- take action to eliminate or reduce, as far as practicable, any potentially adverse environmental impacts identified in our aspects register.
- promote environmental awareness amongst our suppliers, contractors, and partners by implementing operational procedures, processes, and best practices.
- complete internal audits and follow a path of continual improvement.
- ensure that directors and management are fully engaged in the management of environmental issues.
- work in partnership with the community by behaving in a considerate and socially responsible manner.
- ensure effective and expedient incident control, investigation, and reporting.
- assess and, where practicable, reduce the environmental impact of our services.

Directors, management, and supervisory staff have responsibilities for the implementation of the policy.
